Linear algebra has wide applications to diverse areas in natural science, engineering, management and social science. "Linear Algebra"(MATH1111) is a foundation course for all mathematics students, and an important course for all students from the faculty of science. Instructed by a university teacher, this course will provide gifted secondary school students an introduction to the theory and techniques of linear algebra. Upon satisfactory completion of the course, students will be awarded six credits if they eventually study in the faculty of science at HKU (for other HKU faculties, subject to additional approval). Recommendation letters from HKU Mathematics Department are also available for students with satisfactory performance upon request.
