



Regulation for the *Doris Chen Postgraduate Prizes*

Objectives

1. To recognise excellent performance of Research Postgraduate Students (RPGs) in the Department of Mathematics.

Eligibility

2. The Doris Chen Postgraduate Prizes (the Prize(s)) are awarded for excellent research publications and/or PhD/MPhil theses carried out during the specified calendar year (to be called "the award year") by full time RPGs in the Department of Mathematics.
3. For considerations of the Prizes based on research publications, acceptance letters of the publications must be received during January 1 – December 31 of the award year and the student must have full-time candidature for an MPhil or a PhD degree at the time of the issuance of the acceptance letters.
4. For considerations of the Prizes based on a thesis, the Thesis Examination must be carried out during January 1 – December 31 of the award year.

Selection Procedure

5. In order for a student to be considered for the Prize, a nomination letter by the supervisor, stating clearly the reasons for the nomination and the significance of the research results, must be submitted to the Doris Chen Memorial Funds Committee (the Committee).
6. The Committee, excluding the supervisors of the nominees, and with possible co-opted members appointed by the HoD, will evaluate the works and make the selection.

Award

7. Up to two awards each academic year of HK\$10,000 each.
8. Please submit the nomination by 31 January, 2018 to Head of Department.

The regulations are subject to review as deemed appropriate by the Committee to meet future circumstances.
